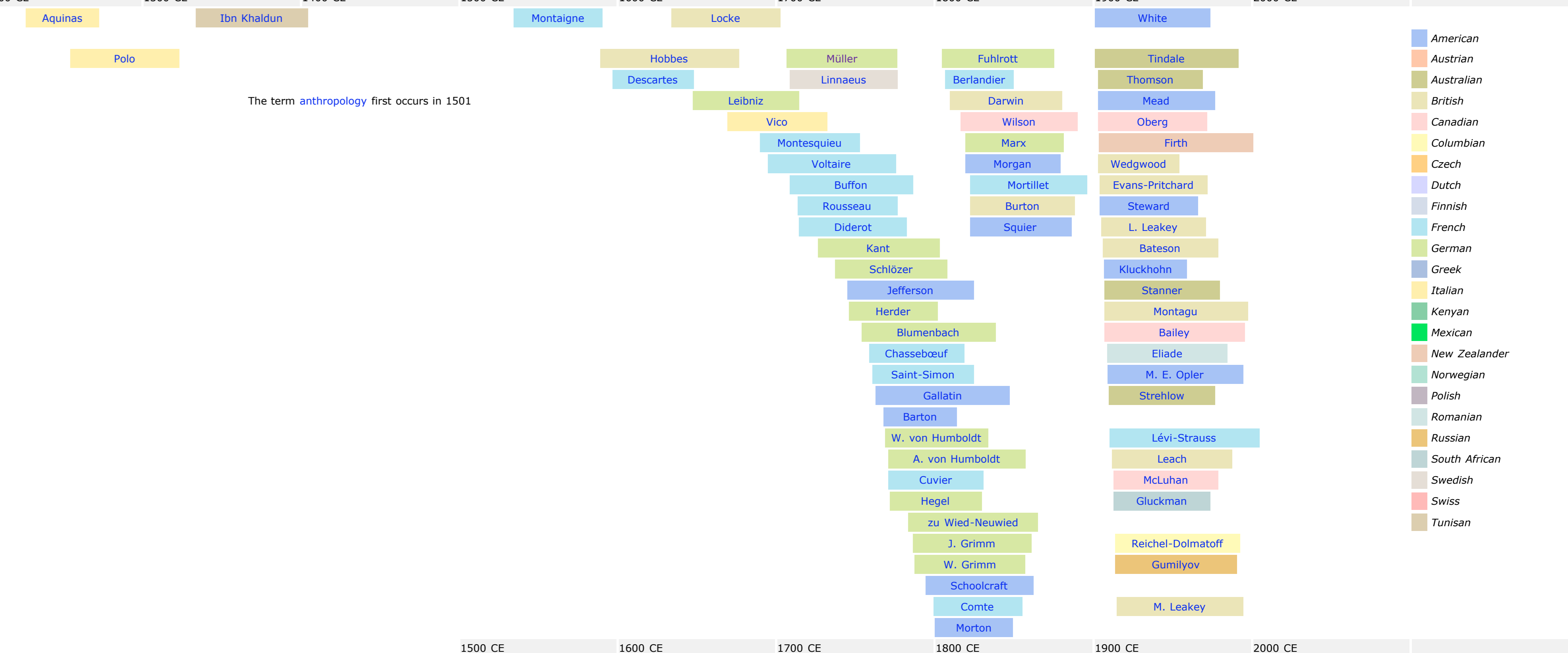

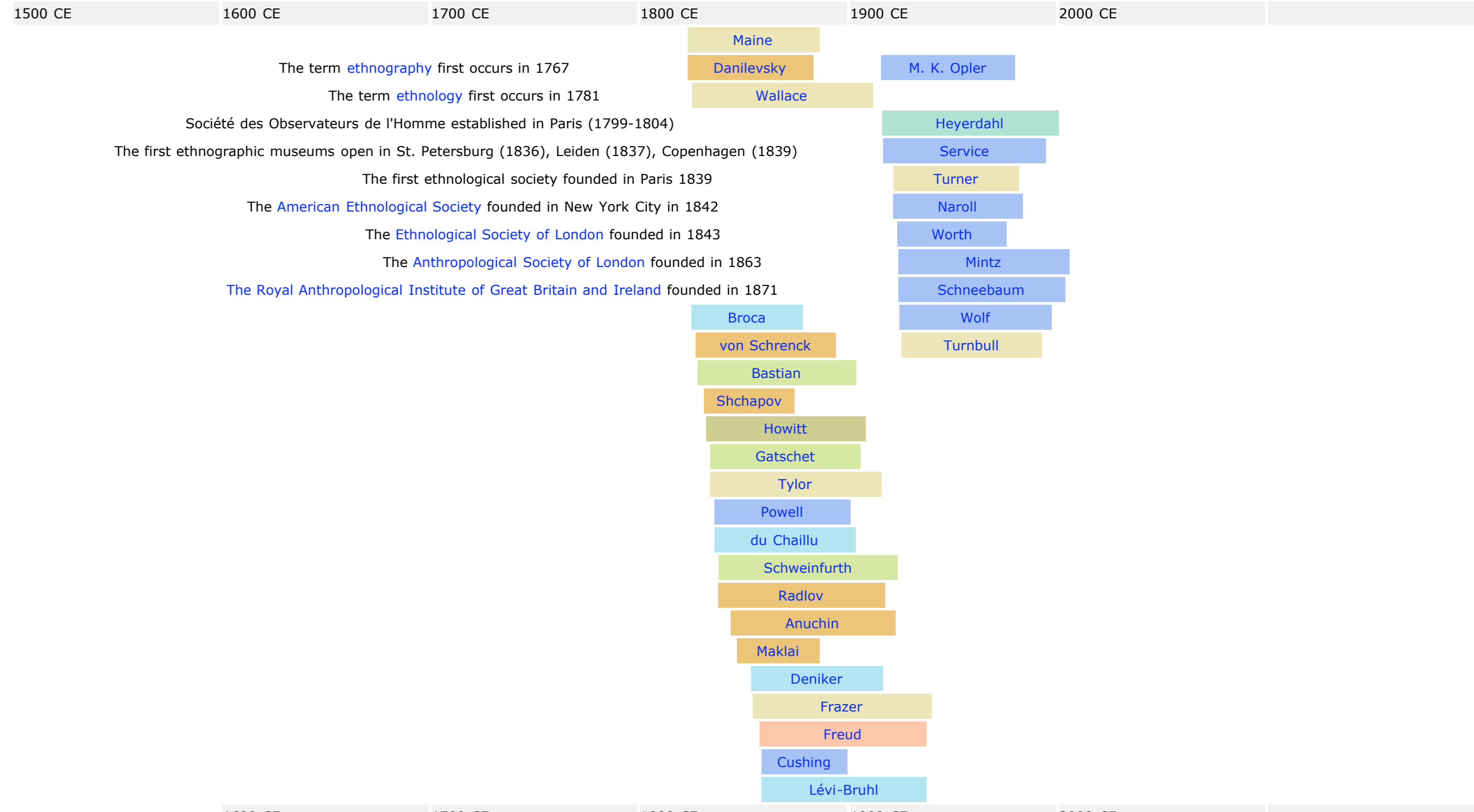

The first ethnological society founded in Paris 1839

The Ethnological Society of London founded in 1843

The Anthropological Society of London founded in 1863

The Royal Anthropological Institute of Great Britain and Ireland founded in 1871
